### **CITY OF OMAHA SOLID WASTE COLLECTION POST-STORM ACTION PLAN**

December 03, 2025 Omaha, NE -- The City of Omaha Public Works Department, Environmental Quality Division, and solid waste hauler FCC Environmental are actively working to recover from collection delays caused by the recent holiday and subsequent weather events. While the current schedule has a one-day delay, some areas have experienced longer interruptions.

#### **Action Plan to Complete Collections**

With cold weather continuing, the primary goal is to complete all collections of recycling, garbage, and yardwaste out for collection by the end of this Saturday. To achieve this, FCC Environmental is temporarily authorized to co-collect garbage and yardwaste where needed for efficiency.

#### **Action for Residents**

- Collection is on a one-day delay from regular schedule
- Ensure your carts and yardwaste materials are fully accessible and clear of snow or ice.
- Collection begins promptly at **6:00 AM**.
- Wait until 7pm the day after your regular collection day to report a missed collection.

#### **Reporting Missed Collections**

Missed collections may be reported to the Solid Waste Hotline at **402-444-5238 after 7:00 PM** on your re-scheduled collection day which is one day behind normal.
