OMAHA YARDWASTE COLLECTION

May 1, 2026, Omaha, NE -- The City of Omaha Public Works Department, Environmental Quality Division, announces that on Monday, May 4, 2026, FCC Environmental will begin the six weeks of no cost yardwaste collection.

For six weeks yardwaste placed in paper yardwaste bags will be collected separately and taken to the Oma-Gro compost facility. No yardwaste stickers are required on the yardwaste bags.

Brush tied in bundles is not included in the no cost separate collection. Brush bundles require yardwaste stickers at all times.

Citizens with any questions about collection may refer to the wasteline.org website, or call the solid waste assistance line at 402-444-5238.

Omaha has a notification service related to solid waste collection. Citizens may sign up for notifications in two ways—

- e-mail notification of impending solid waste collection holidays or service delays related to weather by going to join.wasteline.org.
- The new solid waste app “Wasteline Omaha” available in the Apple App Store and Google Play.
